WeBCan (the West Bridgford Canal Preservation Group) recently celebrated its 1st anniversary & 35 canal enthusiasts attended the AGM on 9 Apr.

Since starting, the group has organised 71 work parties during which groups of volunteers cut & pull invasive groups of reeds, & keep a clear channel of water in the centre of the section of the Grantham Canal between Lady Bay & Radcliffe Rd. This promotes water flow & reduces the risk of the reeds overwhelming the canal.

We need volunteers who can contribute in the following ways: cutting reed, raking, carrying bags of cut reed, planting non-invasive species & keeping brambles at bay. If you would like to take part, we meet 3 times per week:

Sat mornings: 10:00-12:00;

Sun evenings: 5-7pm;

Wed evenings: 6-7pm

Would you like to join the **Lady Bay Hedgehog Highway**? These much-loved animals are struggling to survive, & part of the problem is that garden fences & other boundaries stop them from getting around to find food & mates. Thanks to funding from a Rushcliffe Borough Council grant, supported by Councillors Sue &

Richard Mallender, our group of volunteers has now been able to order tools & equipment to drill holes that will link up gardens in Lady Bay. If you'd like to get your garden on the Hedgehog Highway, email westbridgfordhedgehogs@gmail.com to book an appointment. We'll come to your garden for a site visit, & then can book in a drilling appointment for the coming weeks. Please talk to your neighbours to see what they think - we can only drill a hole where both sides are happy to go ahead. There is no charge for the work to be done.
